**Please Read:** We have mounting concerns regarding dismissal. Many of you are coming to the office to dismiss your child early. At 2:50, the whole school is in transition. Students are changing classes, preparing for sport or tutoring activities, forming bus and afterschool program lines and packing up to go home. The office staff is attempting to call your child through our intercom system, but it is often not heard at that time.

It is not safe for a child, especially in the younger grades, to navigate their way to the office alone. Throughout the day we use the Buddy system, to assure safety. It is not possible to follow that procedure in this transition time.

Therefore, we will no longer be able to accept walk-ins and requests for dismissal at the end of the day. If your child has a scheduled appointment and you have provided the school with a note regarding such, then you must arrange pickup before 2:45 PM.
